The committee wants to know about your activities that go beyond the normal requirements of organization participation. We are very interested in service where you have shown your own initiative. Also, include a detailed list of all your service activities, any leadership positions you may have held and the length of time (hours, days, or years) you participated in that activity. We look forward to reading your application, meeting you and hearing your story. These awards will be given to the top four applicants as scored by the selection committee review of the applications and the interview results. Rotary reserves the right to not award one or more of the scholarships if the committee feels the applicant(s) do not warrant an award. Best wishes in your endeavor.
